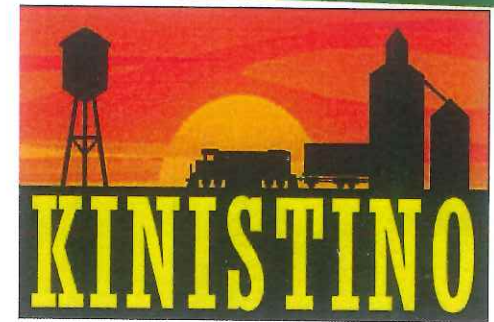

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Single-stream recycling is a system in which all recycle materials - fiber, plastics, tin and aluminum - are placed, unsorted, in the **BLUE** Recycle Cart or Container.

How to use cart:

During the week, keep the cart beside your house. Do not remove cart from assigned address. Do not paint or write on the cart.

- The cart is durable and does not need to be kept inside. Always keep the lid closed. On collection day, place cart on street by 7:00 am or the night before.
- Place cart with wheels close to the curb, with the handle facing the house. Cart must be at least 3 feet away from any vehicle, obstacle, snow bank or another cart. **DO NOT** place the wheels directly against the curb or place cart on sidewalk or boulevard.



Cardboard, Boxboard, Office Paper, Newsprint, Junk Mail, Magazines and Catalogues



Plastic Containers, Milk Cartons & Plastic Milk Jugs

Plastics numbered 1 through 7 (No Food Containers labelled #1)
(No oil containers or chemical jugs, no plastic wrap or bags)



Tin and Aluminum Cans

(cans must be clean, with or without labels – no steel or auto parts)

The following is a list of items by area to help in knowing what to recycle.

Kitchen

Milk jugs & milk cartons
Creamer cartons & bottles
Paper egg cartons
Soup, vegetable, and any other food cans
Aluminum and tin cans
Pie tins
Plastic juice bottles
Yogurt containers
Salad dressing containers
Cereal boxes
Cardboard boxes – unsoiled

Laundry

Laundry soap containers
Spot remover bottles
Bleach containers

Bathroom

Shampoo bottles
Body wash bottles
Conditioner bottles
Plastic hair spray bottles
Plastic shaving containers
Toilet paper cores
Tissue boxes
Plastic pill bottles

Office

Office paper
Catalogues, phone books
Sticky notes, scrap paper
Cardboard boxes flattened

Items not accepted

Styrofoam, ceramics, light bulbs, soiled cardboard, hazardous chemical containers, scrap metal, car parts, plastic toys or household garbage
